

LECTIO DIVINA

Lectio Divina means "divine reading." It is an ancient art of praying the Scriptures. Here is how to pray this way.

- 1) Lectio – Reading/listening - Read the passage slowly and reverently out loud. Realize that God is speaking to you.
- 2) Meditatio – Meditating- Focus on the word or phrase that really speaks to you.
- 3) Oratio – Praying - Dialogue with God allowing God to speak to you and you listen. You speak and then, you listen to God speak to you.
