

## Our Saviour School Family Service Hour Program Policy

During the ISPD process that Our Saviour School has been going through in the past year, it was determined that our school needed to find a way for more parents to become involved in the activities that help make this school such a great place.

It takes many volunteer hours to run the programs at OSS. Many of these programs would not be able to exist without the help of our volunteers. Often it seems that the same families are the ones that do most of the volunteering. In order to try and find a way to provide fair participation by all school families, Our Saviour School will be initiating a Family Service Hour Program. We have studied similar programs in other Catholic schools, considered our mission statement, and realized the value this program would have for the school and parents alike.

Each family will be expected to earn fifteen volunteer points per semester, 30 points a year. Each parent would be able to earn a volunteer point based on the basic rule that one hour of service would be worth one service point. In order for the program to be successful it is important for every family to participate. In addition to helping ensure that the current programs in our school can continue uninterrupted, added benefits to each family will be; an increased awareness of school activities; a chance to meet new people; and an opportunity to help make sure the students continue to have an enriching educational experience at OSS.

If a family has not completed the required 30 hours of volunteer service by the end of the school year, they will be redeemed at \$10 a point. This most definitely is not the preferred method of collection; as we would much rather encourage participation than collect a fee.

Families will be able to sign up for the volunteer jobs at registration and as any other school need arises.

It is our wish that each family becomes a part of the larger family of Our Saviour School and helps make our school continue to be the great school that it is.
